

Borrowing From the Library

Library Cards:

A library card is available free of charge to anyone who lives, works, or owns property in the Tri-Creek area, including the towns of Lowell, Shelby, Schneider and Lake Dalecarlia. A photo ID and a document (gas/water bill, lease, etc.) with your name on it, is all that is required. There is a small charge of \$3.00 for replacement cards. If your card is lost or stolen, report it to us right away. You are responsible for all materials checked out to your card.

Fines and Fees:

To ensure library materials are returned on time, fines and fees are charges when materials are past due. Fines are 25¢ per day on all items except DVDs; overdue DVDS are charged \$1.00 per day. Overdue Inter-Library loans and leased audiobooks are charged 50¢ per day. Items that are borrowed from the Lake County Library will be charged according to their fee schedule.

Patrons are responsible for replacement costs of items that are lost, damaged, or unreturned. Items not returned within six months are considered lost and patrons will be charged the replacement value of the items.

Blocks:

Borrowing privileges are blocked when a patron's total fines and fee amount is \$5.00 or more. Please return your items to the library on time to avoid paying charges.
