

Access to Library Resources

All materials at the Lowell Public Library are available to patrons of all ages on the same basis. This includes books, magazines, videos, compact discs, audio cassettes, books on tape and electronic resources.

The choice of library materials is an individual matter. A person may reject certain items, but does not have a right to restrict access to those materials by others.

It is not possible for library staff to determine whether material is suitable for one individual and not for another. It is not the responsibility of government to tell a family what its children may or may not read, view or listen to. It is the responsibility of the Lowell Public Library to provide a representative collection so that each family can find material appropriate for its need and consistent with its values. State or local laws may restrict the circulation of some items based on the residence of the library user.
