Bill Bradshaw of SCORE (Service Corps of Retired Executives), Sherry Miller from the Lowell Chamber of Commerce, and Barbara Berkley of the Lowell Public Library will be on hand to discuss the many resources and services available to business people.

Jeanenne Holcomb, Director of the Small Business Development Center, and Eric Macom, Lowell Town Business Administer, will also share their ideas and information.

The actual business seminars will then start in December and cover such topics as advertising, marketing, and publicity. After a break for the holidays, the programs will resume in January with discussions on taxes bookkeeping, and employee motivation.

- Judy Vamos went to public relations and problem patron behavior classes.




