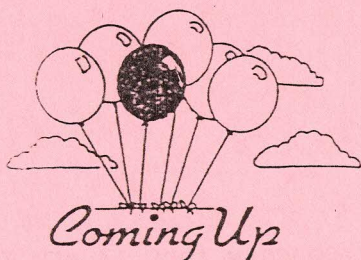
## SHELBY BRANCH TO OPEN

### LITERACY PROGRAM ADDS 14 NEW TUTORS

Fourteen area residents have completed literacy tutor training. The 12-hour course covered phonics, sight words, and comprehension for reading instruction.

The Literacy Program of the Lowell library has been very successful. Ten students are currently meeting with tutors on a weekly basis.

The library has applied for a grant to expand the program to the Lowell Adult Learning Center in Lowell.
