Summer Reading Club Kicks Off

The surf is up and big waves are heading for the Lowell Public Library and its Shelby and Schneider branches as the 2-month-long Summer Reading Club programs for children and young adults are about to begin.

This year's "Surf the Book Wave" program for pre-school and elementary school age children and the "Surf the Reading Wave" program for YAs, (young adult) offers lazy-days-of-summer reading adventure and fun activities.

To kick off the program, young adults, under the direction of YA programmer Debbie Blink will host a "Beach Party Picnic" for all ages at the libraries. Picnic fare is hot dogs, chips, and sodas. The picnics will be held Monday, June 4, 11 AM to 2 PM, at the library, 10:30 AM to 12 Noon at the Shelby Branch Library, and 12 Noon at the Schneider Branch Library.

Children's Programmer, Mrs. Denise Mayhew expects to see hundreds of children heading for the libraries to register for the Summer Reading Program. "Now that required reading of school assignments is over," says Mrs. Mayhew, "this is the time when children can relax and read what, when and how they please. The library has hundreds of new books to add to their reading pleasure."

There's an exciting variety of beach-themed programs scheduled for youngsters who register for the Summer Reading Program including craft programs, beach volleyball, hula hoop contests, book walks and a Mini Carnival. Enhancing the Library Woods

The Lowell Public Library Board of Trustees recently announced the purchase of property adjacent to the library's 5 acre wooded setting. The land, approximately 2/3 of an acre, blends in beautifully with the wooded landscape of the library property which is home to over 300 trees as well as wildflowers and flowering shrubs.

The new property also borders the Library Arbors Nature Trail that winds its way around the perimeter of the library grounds. There are 50 species of trees native to Indiana on the trail. Designed as an educational tool, the trail is a natural habitat for the deer, birds, raccoons, and fox in the area. With the purchase of the new property the library ensures the protection of the integrity of the facility and grounds as well as additional room for expansion in the future.

The Money Bus is coming to the Lowell Public Library! The "Kid's Count on the Money Bus" curriculum is being presented to 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students Three Creeks, Oak Hill and Lake Prairie elementary schools. Students who have had the curriculum can sign up at the library for an hour-long time slot on the bus. The bus will be at the library 9 AM to 12 PM and 1 PM to 4 PM, during June 5th through June 8th and June 12th through June 15.

Sign-up sheets will be available at the circulation desk beginning Tuesday, May 29, for children eligible to board the bus, which can accommodate 15 students per hour. Parents can accompany their children through the Money Bus.

Developed by the Indiana State University's Networks Financial Institute, the bus is a mobile, financial, literacy classroom. The 40-ft bus holds a wealth of fun ways for students to learn the value of money. On the bus students will find vibrant, visual computer activities to play. They can learn concepts including creating a budget, saving and spending money, using an ATM, and managing credit and debit cards.

Before entering the bus, students determine their short term goals. Having completed the curriculum at school they will receive "pretend" paychecks at the library to open a checking and savings account before boarding the bus to begin the Money Bus experience. There are 13 different activities inside and outside the bus students on which students may apply their mathematics and reading skills.

Public viewing of the Money Bus will be held on Monday, June 4, from 11:30 AM to 3:30 PM and Saturday, June 9, from 10 AM to 1 PM.

Children's Paperback Booksale.

The Friends of the Lowell Public Library invites families to shop at the Children's Paper-back Booksale for items for their home library. From June 4, to June 26, the Friends will set up a mini-bookstore in the library's main room, across from the circulation desk.

The theme of the sale is "Surf's Up." complementing the library's beach theme for its Summer Reading Club programs.

At the sale shoppers will find books of adventure, humor, sci-fi, and mystery — scary stories too! Mixed with these books are non-fiction offerings about sports, animals, crafts, biographies, science, etc. Hundreds of quality books in every price range, interest and reading level can be found at the sale. Book marks, posters, journals and diaries, crayons, and fun novelty items are also available at the sale.

Friends receive 50% of the proceeds of the sale which will be used for Summer Reading Club prizes and books for the library's children's collection.


