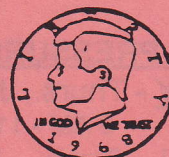

USE YOUR HOME LIBRARY AND SAVE!



There is **No charge** to use the Lowell Public Library or it's branches to people who live or own property in Lowell, Shelby, Schneider, Lake Dale, West Creek, Eagle Creek, or Cedar Creek Townships.

However, beginning July 1st, 1995, a Public Library Access Card (or PLAC), will be required by some public libraries for borrowers who live outside of their districts. The cost of the card will be \$17 per year.

You can save the \$17 by using the Lowell Public Library. Patrons will only need to purchase a PLAC if they wish to borrow materials from the Lake County Public Libraries, either the Central Branch on Route 30, or any of its branches. That same PLAC can be used at almost every public library in the state, although some libraries will not require it.

There is still the option of having materials sent to the Lowell Library from other libraries without charge.

Public Libraries in Indiana are almost entirely supported by local taxes, and receive almost no support from the state. So, when patrons borrow materials from another library district, it means taxpayers of that district are paying the bills. If people who live outside the tax district use another library district's materials, they must be reimbursed in some way. Since state money is not available, that reimbursement will come from the sale of Public Library Access Cards (PLAC,) which by law must be purchased at your home library.

The Lake County Public Library district, despite its name, does not collect taxes from the entire county. Their district takes in only those areas not served by the other library districts in the county...Lowell, Crown Point, Hammond, Gary, East Chicago, and Whiting. **RESIDENTS OF THE THREE CREEKS AREA** (which is the Lowell Library district) **DO NOT PAY TAXES TO THE LAKE COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY.**

The library board and staff regret any inconvenience this may cause our library users. We hope that you will come in to our libraries and let us help your here. In 1996, the Indiana library community will again request permanent state funding for reciprocal borrowing to remove these barriers to lifelong learning.

As soon as we know which libraries will require the PLAC we will let you know.
