Fax Service and Public Scanner Available at Library

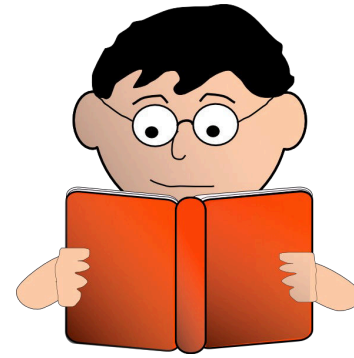

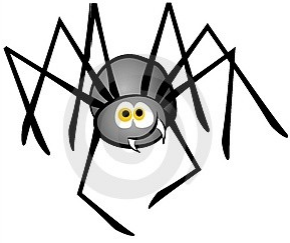
