We've Got OverDrive eBooks!

We are very excited to announce that you can now download eBooks and Audiobooks from the library's website. After logging in with your library card and pin #, you can browse the collection and download to PC, Mac, and many mobile devices. This new service, powered by OverDrive, is provided free by the library to patrons in the Lowell Public Library district.

To get started, you will need to install free software; for Audiobooks: OverDrive® Media Console™. To read eBooks, you'll need Adobe® Digital Editions. To transfer books to other devices you need to register for an Adobe ID. Downloaded books can be enjoyed immediately or transferred to a variety of devices, including the NOOK, Sony Reader, iPod, and many others. Some audio titles can also be burned to CD. Kindle users with a Wi-Fi connection can download most books directly to their Kindle devices, through Amazon. Mobile apps for Android, BlackBerry, iPhone/iPad/iPod touch and Windows Phone 7 allow users to wirelessly download eBooks and Audiobooks directly to those mobile devices. Titles will automatically expire at the end of the lending period. There are no late fees! Ask at the reference desk where to get more help.

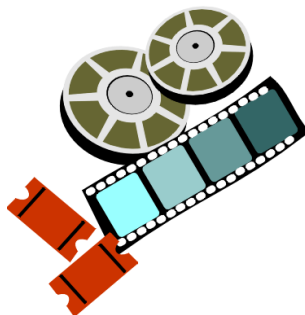

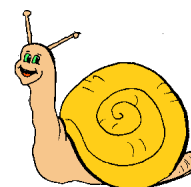
