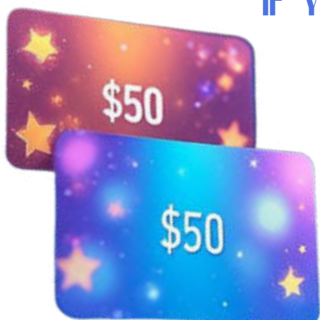
For every book you read you will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win one of two, \$50 gift cards or a variety of exciting treasures. YA Books with dragons count double.
